

Rabbit Housing and Supplies

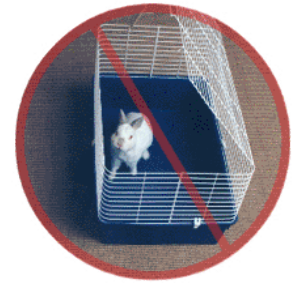


Housing

Rabbits should be kept indoors. Enclosures should be at least 4–6 times the length of your rabbit to ensure she can hop around and stretch out in the enclosure.

Cages should have a solid floor, but a plastic slatted floor is ok. Do not use an enclosure with a wire floor as this will be painful for your rabbit and can damage her feet. Rabbits do not have padded feet. You can also provide a resting board or rug for added comfort.

If your rabbit lives primarily in a cage, provide her with an indoor running area for daily exercise.



Toys and Enrichment

Provide toys and hiding spaces such as upturned cardboard boxes to provide entertainment and enrichment for your rabbit.



Litter Box and Litter

Include a litter box in your rabbit's enclosure, pen, or cage. Use rabbit litter or newspaper, but do not use clumping litter or a hi-corner box.
