ABOUT THE SAN FRANCISCO SPCA

One of the oldest and most progressive animal welfare organizations in the country, the San Francisco SPCA has served the people and animals of San Francisco since 1868.

Their mission is to ensure every companion animal has access to quality medical care, compassionate shelter, and a loving home.

In the 1990s, they founded the No-Kill movement. San Francisco now has one of the lowest euthanasia rates of any major city in the United States (less than 5%) and no adoptable dog or cat in the city goes without a home.

The SF SPCA will impact **5 million animals by 2030** by ensuring access to veterinary care and pet health equity for all.
