One of the oldest and most progressive animal welfare organizations in the country, the San Francisco SPCA has served the people and animals of San Francisco since 1868.

**Their mission is to ensure every companion animal has access to quality medical care, compassionate shelter, and a loving home.**

In the 1990s, they founded the No-Kill movement. San Francisco now has one of the lowest euthanasia rates of any major city in the United States (less than 5%) and no adoptable dog or cat in the city goes without a home.

The SF SPCA will impact **5 million animals by 2030** by ensuring access to veterinary care and pet health equity for all.
